

Dear Parent/Carer

Following the Government's announcement that schools will close from Monday, I would like to outline how we as a school are going to support your child during these uncertain times.

- Free School Meal children will still be able to access free meals; the kitchen will prepare a daily lunch-bag for each child, which can be collected from the kitchen every day at 12.00pm. The office will contact you each Monday to ascertain on which days your child will require a lunch-bag.
- Home learning will be available via our school website: <http://chancelprimary.co.uk/> outlining three lessons per day, which your child will need to work through. You will find the weekly digital timetable uploaded to the website, every Monday morning – available from 9.00 am.
- Each child will be issued with a Home Learning Pack, consisting of stationery and an exercise book to complete the above learning activities.

Should you require any further assistance, guidance or support, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

Children of key-workers, who will be attending school, will be provided with a free meal every day; unfortunately we are unable to provide a specific menu at this point in time, but will endeavour to let you know the meal choices in advance. Children are of course welcome to bring their own packed lunch each day and a snack for break-time.

School will be open to these pupils from 7.30 am until 5.45 pm each day, there will be no charges incurred for using the Before and After School Club [BASC] at this time.

In order to ease any anxieties your child may be experiencing, we are allowing all children attending school, to come dressed in non-uniform – enabling them to fully engage in a wide range of physical and creative activities staff are preparing for them.

Children attending school, will need to be dropped off and collected via the atrium door. If not attending BASC, your child should arrive at school by no later than 8.55am and be collected at 3.30pm.

We are undoubtedly entering unknown territory, which will rely on each and every one of us playing our part for the greater good. I would like to take this opportunity to wish you all well, and hope that you and your families remain safe.
