Each week children will be given a list of words- in Year 6 there will be **10 weekly spellings**, comprising of 7 words related to a rule and 3 words from the Y3/4/5/6 statutory spelling list. In some weeks, we may send home more than 7 spelling rule spellings but will only test 7. In the final week of the half term, children will be tested on a range of words that they have been practising during this time. Please be aware that they will be tested on the sounds and rules and so some words may not have appeared specifically in the previous lists.
