Issues identified from September 2020 as barriers to learning (e.g. curriculum gaps / literacy / attendance / wellbeing)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Clear gaps in pupils' knowledge and understanding in the core subjects of English, Mathematics and Science ❖ Changes to routines means adjustments are required to support high quality Teaching and learning within the new normal ❖ Reading and writing attainment have not progressed at the expected rate ❖ Maths attainment has not progressed at the expected rate ❖ Students' ability to write for extended periods has regressed ❖ Numbers of students experiencing anxiety whilst adjusting to new school routines, post extended period in lockdown has increased ❖ Attendance of students with SEMH and anxiety has increased leading to additional loss in learning time ❖ Students not able to access technology or remote learning support materials may fall behind peers with access to technology

Six	Maths boosters	To ensure identified pupils' in Year 6 receive intensive maths intervention to plug gaps in learning and ensure they reach age related expectations.	£1 500
All	Additional LSAs for pastoral support.	To ensure pupils with SEMH and anxiety issues are well supported throughout the school day.	£ 3 250
All	Additional Nurture training for PSO	To ensure both pupils and their families can access professional support for SEMH	£1 250

Monitoring the impact of 'Covid Catch-up' grant spending

- ❖ Data tracking that identifies the gaps - data tracking is used rigorously across the whole school and identifies all underachieving pupils. All year groups conducted a baseline assessment, to analyse the real effect of lockdown on pupils' attainment and wellbeing. This will be tracked and analysed every half term.
- ❖ Termly monitoring schedules are in place to ensure SLT focus on all areas of learning to ensure pupils are exposed to a high quality education.
- ❖ Tracking attendance of all pupils. Systems are in place to make early identification of issue and need.
